HOLIDAY PROGRAMME

DAY 1

Departure by scheduled flight to Bali. It's expected a change of aircraft. Meals and overnight on board.

DAY 2

Arrival in Denpasar and meeting with Suci Tour guide. Transfer to 4 star beach front hotel in Seminyak. Check in and free time. Free for dinner.

DAY 3

Breakfast and free morning to relax after the long trip. In the afternoon, at 3.00 pm, meeting with the guide and departure to visit Tanah Lot, a famous Hindu temple perched on the cliff. 6.00 pm, back to the hotel and free for dinner.



DAY 4

Breakfast.

08.30 am Meeting with the guide and departure for the village of Batubulan where we stop in a theater for the performance of traditional dance "Barong & Kriss".

11.00 am departure and, for those interested, stop by the Gold & Silver Art market for shopping.

1.00 pm arrival in Tegalalang to admire the spectacular terraced rice fields and have lunch in a typical Indonesian restaurant overlooking the valley surrounded by palm plantations.

3.00 pm Departure for Ubud where we visit the monkey forest.

5.00 Back to hotel and free for dinner.



DAY 5

Breakfast and check out.

Meeting with guide and transfer to Benoa harbor where you will be welcomed by the staff of Ombak Puthi and transferred on board.

Today begins the cruise in the next 7 days you will be assisted by staff of Ombak Puthi.

Expected departure in the late morning.

DAY 6-7-8-9-10

Cruise. The detailed program is described below.

DAY 11

Back to Bali via short domestic flight.

Upon your arrival in Bali you will be welcomed by Suci Tour guide and transferred to hotel.

Check in and rest of the day free.

DAY 12

Free time for relax e shopping.

DAY 13

Meeting with guide and transfer to airport and departure for Italy.

DAY 14

Arrival in Italy and end of your holiday.

CRUISE PROGRAMME



DAY 1 Departure from Bali

Eembarkation at Benoa Harbor, Bali. The ship will depart around 9:00 AM. After lunch you visit the traditional Bali Aga village of Tenganan (East Bali). At night, you will cross the famous "Wallace Line" on your way to Lombok. The Strait between Bali and Lombok marks an important ecological boundary, first described by Sir Alfred Russel Wallace, the British naturalist. He noticed that the flora and fauna of the islands to the west are home to Asiatic animal and plant species, whereas the islands to the east of that ölineö have a greater similarity to species found in Australia.

DAY 2 Lombok

We will stop at Lombok Harbour on the Eastern shore of the island to visit a traditional pottery center, several small villages and to witness a traditional dance performance.

DAY 3 Satonda - Sumbawa

You'll set foot on to the little known island of Satonda with its stunning Crater Lake and beautiful coral gardens. Located just a couple of miles off the north-west coast of Sumbawa, Satonda is what remained of an extinct volcano of which the caldera was filled with water when nearby Mount Tambora erupted in 1815. This was the biggest volcanic eruption in the collective memory of mankind, much larger than Krakatoa. With an estimated volume of 160 cubic kilometers of rocks and ash ejected from the volcano the following year became known as the "year without a summer" because of the effect on North American and European weather. A highlight of our visit to Satonda is the sight of many thousands of flying foxes that commute at dusk from the island to feed on the mainland, returning before first light the next day. Immediately after sunset, Ombak Putih leaves for an overnight passage on a course due east.



DAY 4 Bima ó Sumbawa

In Bima on the island Sumbawa you visit the local market and a village where the inhabitants will demonstrate some traditional dances. Most famous is the *adu kepala* or the ritual head-to-head combat.

DAY 5 Komodo

Very early in the morning we will anchor off Komodo Island for the first of two days in the National Park. We will go ashore at the rangers' station in Loh Liang in search of the world famous Komodo dragons. In the afternoon we go to one of the beaches nearby for some spectacular snorkeling. The National Park is world-known for its teeming underwater world.

The plankton-rich seas around Komodo support amazing reefs and a range of large marine life, including whales and dolphins.



DAY 6 Komodo - Rinca

We will visit the ranger station of Loh Buaya on Rinca Island. This dry and rugged island is well-known for its diverse wildlife. Apart from Komodo dragons, we may spot monkeys, wild buffaloes and deer. From the top of the hills, the scenery is spectacular. In the evening our crew will prepare an evening beach barbecue and we will enjoy a star studded night sky.



DAY 7 Lubahan Bajo - Bali

After a last early morning swim we enter the harbor of Labuhanbajo in West Flores in the course of the morning and around noon we fly back to Bali.

LA BARCA

OMBAK PUTHI is a classic Phinisi Schooner 36 meters length, able to carry up to 24 passengers. All cabins are air conditioned and private bathroom. Although built in traditional style, Ombak Puthi is a modern ship, built between 1996 and 1997 and equipped with all amenities.

There are 12 double cabins. The deck is very spacious, there is a large lounge with air conditioning and a large area for outdoor living raised. Ombak Puthi is built with fine wood Teak and Iron Wood.

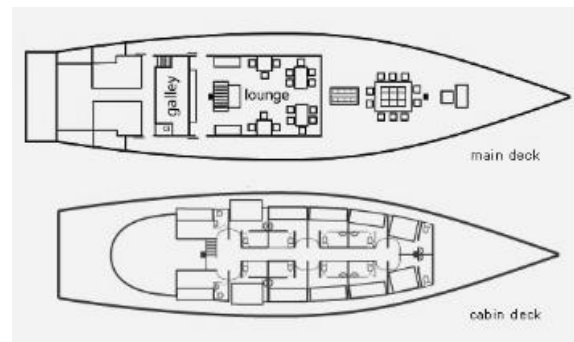

BALI INFORMATION

Documents: for stays not exceeding 30 days is required passport valid for at least 6 months.

Vaccinations: health prevention is not required for those who went to Bali.

Medicines: are advised to bring a commonly used medicines for fever, flu, infections.

Currency: The local currency is the rupee. Credit cards, euros and dollars are accepted.

Language: The official language is Bahasa Indonesia. Also widely available in English.

Time: 7 hours ahead of Italy.

Climate: equatorial climate, dry from April to October, wet from November to March.

Electricity: Electrical is 220 volts. It is advised to bring a universal adapter.

Clothing: We recommend wearing light clothing and do not forget a sweater or jacket for cooler places and spaces with air conditioning.

Religion: Hinduism

Laws: the law on drugs, both light and heavy, is extremely severe. There is no distinction between possession and trafficking of drugs and between soft and hard drugs. Even the crimes of sexual abuse or violence against children are treated with the utmost severity.

Tipping: Not obligatory, but welcome.
